CEGH Incorporates Platts European Biomethane Price Assessment into CEGH GreenGas Platform!

- CEGH, through enhanced collaboration with [S&P Global Energy Platts](#) now publishes additional Platts price assessment data to support market price transparency and liquidity in European Biomethane markets.

Central European Gas Hub AG (CEGH), located in Vienna, Austria, is pleased to announce this significant enhancement to its price transparency offerings on its **CEGH GreenGas Platform** and its extension of cooperation with S&P Global Energy Platts.

Beginning with July 2026, CEGH will integrate the recently-launched **Platts daily European unsubsidized waste biomethane guarantees of origin (GO) assessments** on the CEGH GreenGas Platform which references the buying and selling of green hydrogen and biomethane across EU countries and the neighboring states - Switzerland, Norway, Turkey, United Kingdom and Ukraine. This collaboration underscores CEGH's commitment to support the establishment of a transparent, efficient, and liquid market for green gases across Europe.

Empowering the Market with Critical Data

The new daily Platts price assessments, published under the **EUB (European Unsubsidized Biomethane)** label, provide a benchmark for 1) current year and 2) year-ahead unsubsidized waste biomethane certificates. The Platts price assessments reflect the most competitive certified unsubsidized waste biomethane of European origin.

This feature of the **CEGH GreenGas Platform** comes at a critical juncture, when unsubsidized waste biomethane plays an increasingly pivotal role in **compliance markets** – from road and maritime transportation to future grid blending requirements. By integrating these Platts price assessments, **CEGH is better enabling** market participants to take informed trading decisions, support Europe's decarbonization goals and help grow the renewable gas markets.

With over **130 registered members** from 26 different countries, the platform continues to expand its services, marking it a central marketplace for trading biomethane, green hydrogen, and certificates across **all EU member states**, as well as Switzerland, Norway, Turkey, Ukraine, and the United Kingdom. Ongoing Platform Development

The CEGH GreenGas Platform is continuously enhanced based on user feedback. It currently supports certificates from all EU countries, including Ukraine. To ensure transparency and compliance with national regulations, it integrates biogas register data from Austria (E-Control, AGCS), Germany (DENA), and Denmark (Energinet). These developments are key to enabling seamless, cross-border renewable gas trading in Europe.

Background information:

Central European Gas Hub:

Central European Gas Hub AG (CEGH) is the operator of the Virtual Trading Point (VTP) in Austria and provides a gas nomination platform for international gas companies. The Gas Exchange products for the Austrian and Czech markets are offered on EEX Gas in cooperation between EEX and CEGH.

CEGH is a subsidiary of OMV Gas Logistics Holding (65%), Wiener Boerse (20%) and Eustream (15%). In 2025, CEGH has proven its position as one of Central Europe's leading trading platforms when it achieved a nominated volume of 550 TWh of natural gas at the CEGH VTP, despite the Russian gas transit stop through Ukraine.
